Read books, sing songs, repeat the sounds your baby is making. Even though a conversation with your baby may seem one sided, it's important to have that communication with your baby.

### Family Connection

Peek-a-boo is a great way to get your baby to smile, giggle, and coo. You can use your hands or a thin blanket to cover your face. Cover your face for a few seconds, take away your hands/blanket and say "Peek-a-boo"! Babies love when you play this game with them.
