

Hi everyone!

We are quickly approaching the re-opening of LLL. I can't wait to see all of you!

I wanted to update you on a few things and also want to put a list of things to bring on your first day back.

- I will need an updated intake form. I will attach that in the e-mail. If you are unable to print this, please let me know. We need an updated form because I'm sure your baby has changed a lot during the last two months and will need all of this new information.

Remind App

We will be using the Remind app. I am very new with it, and it seems like it will be easy to use. Here is a link to the app, to add the Infant classroom. <https://www.remind.com/join/fbayer>

We will be able to communicate through that. I will be able to send pictures and talk about your child's day. It's going to be very strange not being able to see any of you. I would really appreciate that if each morning you send me a message with the following information:

When your baby woke up.

When your baby last ate and what.

If your baby had any medications.

Things to bring to daycare:

- Diapers
- Wipes in a hard container (not allowed to keep out plastic wipe bags)
- Pacifier if they use one--If your child uses a pacifier that is attached to an animal, please be sure to bring an extra pacifier that is NOT attached to an animal for use in the crib. Pacifiers with animals attached are not allowed in the cribs
- Bottles/Formula/Food---LABEL all with names and you need to put a date if it needs to be stored in the fridge
- Pre-made bottles/Breastmilk needs to be labeled with name and date
- Extra clothes
- Blanket
- Sleepsack
- Jacket for outside
- Extra shoes if they are walking to use only at daycare
- Small bag that I can put their dirty bottles/clothes in
- Diaper cream and medication form filled out

Since things are very different with COVID-19 going on, we are asking to bring extra clothes for your child to be changed into right away when they arrive at daycare. I would suggest maybe just keeping them in their pajamas, and then when they arrive I can change them into their outfit for the day. If your child is walking, please bring the extra shoes that they would keep at daycare and that we could sanitize each day.

For new families, since you will not be able to come into the center, if you would like to set up a video call with me that would be great. I know it would be hard to bring my child to daycare not knowing who was going to be taking care of them. Please let me know if you would like to do this.

LLL will be using Banana Boat 50 SPF sunscreen this summer. If you would like us to use that for your baby, it will be a \$7 charge for the summer. I will need you to sign the permission form and bring that on the first day back. If you want to bring your own sunscreen, I will need you to fill out a medical form. Please bring the sunscreen on your first day back. If your baby is under 6 months of age, please have clothes at daycare that I would be able to put on them when we go outside that covers their legs and arms.

If you have a sun hat for your baby that would be great to have for outside. Babies are so sensitive to the sun, so I would like to be able to protect them the best that I can.

If you have any questions at all please ask. I feel like I covered what I could think of. It's going to be strange doing some of the things that we have to do, but hopefully this won't last long. I can't wait to see everyone soon!
